Dear Medicare/Medi-Cal Provider,

Subject: Price Adjustment

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has determined that crossover claims may have been underpaid for procedure codes J7620 (albuterol, up to 2.5 mg and ipratropium bromide, up to 0.5 mg, FDA-approved final product, non-compounded administered through [Durable Medical Equipment] DME) and J7613 (albuterol, inhalation solution, FDA-approved final product, non-compounded, administered through DME, unit dose, 1 mg). The Medi-Cal system was fixed February 18, 2008 as follows:

- J7620 – reimbursement defaults to the Medicare allowable rates, effective November 1, 2006.
- J7613 – the quantity restriction was removed, effective August 1, 2007.

EDS is adjusting the affected paid claims and resubmitting the affected claims that were suppressed due to a previous price of zero. These adjustments will appear on *Remittance Advice Details* (RADs) beginning April 10, 2008 with RAD code **0912: Crossover price correction**. Resubmits will appear on RADs beginning April 17, 2008, with Claim Control Number (CCN) prefix **809088**.

If you disagree with any of these adjustments or resubmits, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual or on the Medi-Cal Web site ([www.medi-cal.ca.gov](http://www.medi-cal.ca.gov)).
