Subject: Resubmission of Claims

EDS, an HP company, has discovered a system error that resulted in the erroneous denial of claims for recipients enrolled in Cancer Detection Program: Every Woman Counts (CDP: EWC). This error was in place since October 2002, until the date of processing of December 18, 2008.

No action is required on your part. EDS is resubmitting the affected claims. These resubmits will be paid, or denied for a valid reason. The resubmits will appear on *Remittance Advice Details* (RADs) beginning November 19, 2009, with Claim Control Number (CCN) prefix **931655**.

If you disagree with any of these resubmits, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date.
