Subject: Void of Claims

Dear Provider:

Claims with procedure code J9025 (injection, azacitidine, 1 mg) were erroneously paid for dates of service from October 22, 2009 – October 22, 2012, as these claims were billed with an incorrect diagnosis code.

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has updated the Procedure Master File for procedure code J9025 to prevent further erroneous payment. No action is required on your part. These claims will appear as voids on Remittance Advice Details (RADs) beginning June 13, 2013, with RAD code **0862: Void of Claim with Non-Payable Diagnosis**; Claim Control Number (CCN) prefix: **315877**.

The recoveries are authorized under the provisions of *Welfare and Institutions Code* (W&I Code), Sections 14176 and 14177, and *California Code of Regulations* (CCR) Title 22, Section 51458.1(a)(1). In addition, the W&I Code sections authorize DHCS to enter into repayment agreements with providers or offset overpayments against amounts due. If the total warrant amount is not sufficient to offset the recovery, the negative balance will be converted to an accounts receivable transaction and subtracted from future Medi-Cal reimbursements.

If you disagree with any of these voids, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual or on the Medi-Cal website (www.medi-cal.ca.gov).
