Subject: Adjustment of Erroneously Reduced Claims for Family Planning Services and Health Access Programs

Dear Provider:

Mandated by Assembly Bill 97 (Chapter 3, Statutes of 2011), the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is exempting all family planning services under the Family PACT (Planning, Access, Care and Treatment) Program designated by aid code 8H, as well as some Health Access Programs, from the 10 percent provider payment reduction, effective for dates of service on or after June 1, 2011. Previously, some of these services were erroneously subjected to the payment reduction.

No action is required on your part. Xerox State Healthcare, LLC (Xerox) is adjusting the affected claims for dates of service on or after June 1, 2011. Adjustments began appearing on *Remittance Advice Details* (RAD) beginning December 12, 2013, under RAD code **0951: Adjustment to 10% provider payment reduction per Assembly Bill 97 (Chapter 3, Statutes of 2011) effective 06/01/2011.**

If you disagree with any of these adjustments, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual, or on the Medi-Cal website (www.medi-cal.ca.gov).
