Subject: Adjustment of Genetic Disease Screening Program Claims

Dear Provider:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) directed Xerox State Healthcare, LLC (Xerox) to exempt the Genetic Disease Screening Program (GDSP) from the 10 percent provider payment reduction, mandated by Assembly Bill 97 (Chapter 3, Statutes of 2011), for dates of service on or after June 1, 2011. The system was changed on November 22, 2013.

No action is required on your part. Xerox will adjust the affected claims. These adjustments will appear on *Remittance Advice Details* (RAD) beginning August 21, 2014, with RAD code **0951: Adjustment to 10% provider payment reduction per Assembly Bill 97 (Chapter 3, Statutes of 2011) effective 06/01/2011.**

If you disagree with any of these adjustments, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date or you may submit an *Appeal Form* within 90 days of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual or on the Medi-Cal website (www.medi-cal.ca.gov).
