**Subject: Retroactive Adjustment of Claims for LTC Rate Changes**

Dear Provider:

From August 2014 through September 2014, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) updated several Long Term Care (LTC) rates effective retroactively to various dates, some as early as August 1, 2009.

No action is required on your part. Xerox State Healthcare, LLC (Xerox), will adjust the affected claims. These adjustments will appear on *Remittance Advice Details* (RAD) beginning January 22, 2015 (for positive adjustments), and February 5, 2015 (for negative adjustments), with RAD code **0829: LTC retro rate adjustment**.

The recoveries are authorized under the provisions of *Welfare and Institutions Code* (W&I Code), Sections 14176 and 14177, and *California Code of Regulations* (CCR), Title 22, Section 51458.1(a)(1). In addition, the W&I Code sections authorize DHCS to enter into repayment agreements with providers or offset overpayments against amounts due. If the total warrant amount is not sufficient to offset the recovery, the negative balance will be converted to an accounts receivable transaction and subtracted from future Medi-Cal reimbursements.

If you disagree with any of these adjustments, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date or you may submit an *Appeal Form* within 90 days of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual or on the Medi-Cal website ([www.medi-cal.ca.gov](http://www.medi-cal.ca.gov)).
